

Notice on COVID-19 Test Requirements in Wards

To protect the health and safety of you and your family
Each patient in a ward is limited to **1** accompanying person (including the Division of Hematology & Oncology for Children), both must present proof of COVID-19 testing.

(We accept reports from CDC-appointed testing facilities)

 The accompanying person must provide PCR test performed 2 days prior to **FIRST** entering the hospital




Map for the Screening Stations

 **Venue:** COVID Clinic/3rd screening station

 **Rules :** Free test → (1) Those who were confirmed with COVID-19 and is within 3 months from been released from quarantine


(2) **Those who have completed vaccination (Note)**

Pay for own test → Those who have **NOT** completed vaccination and for each **additional person** (inclusive)

 **Fees:** ① Pooling PCR, NT\$998 at own expense (report on the next day)
② Regular PCR, NT\$3,500 at own expense (fast report)

 For the accompanying person (Weekly Pooling PCR test required starting from the **2nd** week).

 **Venue:** COVID Clinic/3rd screening station

 **Rules:** Pay for own test → Those who have **NOT** completed vaccination
Exempted from the test → Those who have **completed vaccination (Note)**, those who were confirmed with COVID-19 and is within 3 months from been released from quarantine

 **Fees:** NT\$500 at own expenses

★ **Note:** Definition of complete vaccination ⇒ ① Those who have completed the **booster shot** ② Those who have completed the **necessary** vaccination for over 14 days (inclusive) and within 3 months; those who are over 3 months will need to proceed with the test **at own expense**.

★ If the patient/accompanying person needs to go out, a Pooling PCR test (NT\$500) at their own expense will be required on the 3rd day after returning to the hospital (the returning day will be the 1st day)
