Guidelines for COVID-19 Rapid Screening (Hospital Admission Edition)

Please refrain from accompanying the patient unnecessarily. Patients should be limited to one fixed accompanying party (including the Division of Pediatric Hematology) unless there are exceptional circumstances or diseases that necessitate more than one person. In addition, the accompanying person must not have symptoms related to COVID-19. During the period of accompanying the patient, avoid going out and submit to the same health monitoring as the admitted patient.

Accompanying Person

①Asymptomatic: If deemed necessary by the doctor, at-home rapid COVID-19 antigen tests may be performed on symptomatic individuals under

government funding.

2 Symptomatic: On the day of keeping the patient company, one government-funded at-home rapid COVID-19 antigen test is permitted for those falling under cases A and B below. If the test result is negative, hospital companionship is granted.

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Case A: With COVID-19-related symptoms: A fever ≥38 °C, respiratory symptoms, abnormal sense of smell or taste, diarrhea with unknown cause, etc.

Case B: During the self-administered health administration period.
